With Follow-Up in March & April 2016

One Year Later: Follow-Up Survey March & April 2016

At the bottom of the survey, participants are asked to provide an email address if they would like to participate further or be contacted when the work was published. Missing numbers represent people who did not provide an address. Of the 51 who filled out the survey, 37 provided email addresses.

On **March 15, 2016**, a **Follow-Up on the Mobile Tech Survey/ Seguimiento Encuesta sobre Tecnología Digital** en el Camino email was sent to all 37 email addresses in English and Spanish. Four of the email addresses did not work. Some of the email addresses provided were illegible and, despite trying different combinations, were continually bounced back. **Zero responses were received on the follow-up email!**

One month later, on **April 27, 2016** a second email was sent to try and stimulate a response from someone who might have thought about it but didn't follow-through the month before. Rather than send the form in bilingual format, I resent the email in the language the person filled out the form to try and make it 'easier'.

The second sending on April 27, 2016 produced two responses on the same day; a Spanish man (#26) and an Australian woman (#48). The Spanish man wrote to acknowledge the request and that he would get back to me over the weekend because he was too busy during the work week. The Australian woman answered the questions completely. One week later on May 3rd, a Canadian woman (#22) also filled out the form completely. The Spanish man never responded again and the two other women gave responses incorporated into the main article.

In conclusion, the one-year follow-up produced three responses (of the 37 original participants who provided emails) after two attempts to contact participants: two of the responses provided answers to the questions but the third response did not follow-up on the intention to respond.
